TOTAL TO DATE OF PLEDGES: \$391,449
TOTAL CASH TO DATE RECEIVED: \$62,778.72,
 which is \$8,363 over our Annual Appeal Goal and we shall receive a check for 60 percent of that. **IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THE 60 percent we receive immediately be divided. I request that checks get immediately cut from the 1/4 of the parish to go towards parish property debt and 1/4 of the schools to be sent directly for the past payroll debt incurred last year. AS MANY OF YOU KNOW, in the past before I arrived, there were capital campaigns that stated that funds would be used to lower the debt of the property, but were actually used for operating expenses. THIS WILL NOT HAPPEN in this campaign.**
